Fundraising Opportunities for HCCS!

<u>Chief Supermarket Receipts</u>: HCCS receives funding for all Chief receipts collected during the school year. Please collect and tell your friends and family! You can send receipts in the M&M envelope or drop them off at the school office.

Kroger Community Cares Program: This program makes fundraising easy by donating to HCCS based on the Kroger shopping you do. Here's how it works:
