Halloween week information:

- 1. Please refrain from wearing/bringing costumes or any pieces of costumes or other Halloween props to school on any day besides Friday November 1st.
- 2. Students should not wear their costumes to school on November 1st, they will be given the opportunity in the afternoon to change into their costumes before their party/ parade.

(Halloween parties are classroom specific, please see your weekly classroom newsletters for more information.)

3. Costumes should not only be school appropriate, no blood, no gore, no violence of any kind, no guns, no knifes, no zombies, no vampires, no face paint, no inflatables, no tall boots or high heels, etc. Costumes should not be bulky or hard for students to walk or move around in. Students should be able to put costumes on themselves with little to no assistance.

Halloween Parade

- 1. Students are expected to wear uniform tops and bottoms to Mass and can bring a non-uniform t-shirt to change into after Mass.
- 2. Parade starts at 2:00pm.
- Parents are welcome to come and watch the parade from the parking lot. Students will walk through the pick-up line from one end to the other and then come back inside the school for costume judging by Mayor McCann before being dismissed.
- 4. Please do not use the pick-up lanes for dismissal until after dismissal has begun.



Color-A-Thon™ Color Dust Information: We will rock your world with color but never take your health for granted!! Our Color Blast Dust is safe, non-toxic and completely washable!

Ingredients include: Corn starch and FD&C and/or D&C colors

If participants would like to preserve the color in their shirt, spray

it with vinegar and iron it.

Color Dust Blower station: volunteers will blow the excess color off of participants using A leaf blower on the lowest setting.!

Parent/guardians/carpool drivers: to bring old towels to lay on the seats of vehicles for the trip home.

Students should wear shoes that they won't mind getting dirty. The Color Dust can be washed out of clothing and shoes, but depending on the type of clothing, how long the dust sits on the clothing and the different methods of washing, cleaning results may vary. Be sure to wash all clothing worn during the color run in a separate load on cold and rinse.

SPECTATORS are <u>WELCOME</u>!! Please feel free to come to the South end of the school and watch all the FUN happen!

DISMISSAL: On Oct. 31st Students will dismiss from the playground! If your child is participating in the Color Run they will not be allowed to ride the bus! All Color Run Participants must be car riders!
