Wednesday, Dec. 18th- Dress up For Jesus


Wear you best outfit for Mass.

Santa VS Grinch Penny War

Rules:

Pennies (Positive Points): Pennies are worth positive points. The more pennies your person contributes, the higher their score.

Nickels (Negative Points): Nickels are worth -5 points for the other teams. So if someone adds a nickel to another team's jar, they lose 5 points.

Dimes (Negative Points): Dimes are worth -10 points for other teams. Like nickels, they are used to sabotage other teams.

Quarters (Negative Points): Quarters are worth -25 points for other teams, and they are your most powerful sabotage coin.

Paper Money (Positive Points): Paper money is worth positive points. \$1 bill = 100 points, \$5 bill = 500 points, etc.
