Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are excited to introduce this year's Super Readers Clubs at Holy Cross Catholic School! This club is a fun and motivating way to encourage our students to go above and beyond in their reading outside the classroom.

What is Super Reader?

Super Readers is an extra reading club designed to celebrate students who put in extra effort to grow their reading skills. Students who meet specific reading goals based on their grade level will earn special recognition, prizes and a celebration at the end of the term!

Here's how students can qualify to become a Super Reader:

- Young 5s: Take one AR test and receive any score.
- Kindergarten: Earn 25 AR points.
- 1st- 2nd Grade: Earn 50 AR points.
- 3rd- 4th Grade: Earn 100 AR points.
- 5th- 6th Grade: Read 2,500 pages and a passing AR test or a two- paragraph paper:
 - Paragraph 1: A summary of the book (at least 3 sentences).
 - Paragraph 2: What student learned or gained from the book (at least 3 sentences).

Once a student reaches their goal, they should let Mrs. Tobias know. Students who meet their reading goal will be recognized during morning announcements and receive:

- A Super Readers t-shirt (that can be worn any day, but Mass day (Wednesday))
- A certificate of achievement
- Their photo posted on the Super Readers bulletin board

Students who meet their goal more than once will receive:

- An additional certificate
- An add-on for their t-shirt
- A star next to their photo on the Super Readers bulletin board

For example kindergartener get 25 more points and receives their achievements each time.

The deadline for Super Readers will be May 1st. This is only the deadline for Super Readers and not the end of AR.

To celebrate all of our Super Readers, we will host a Super Readers' Party on Thursday, May 14th 2026! More details to follow.

We're proud to support a culture of literacy and excellence, and we're so excited to see our students challenge themselves and discover the joy of reading.

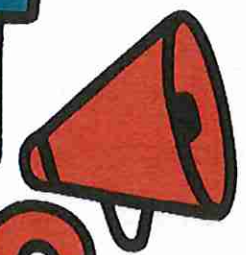
